EXCURSION

EX-1: Tour of Sake and Soba-making (Box Lunch Included) - Limited to 20 PERSON

Date: June 20(Sun) Time: 12:30-17:00 Fare: JPY7,500

Sake: Japanese Sake has played a central role in the life and culture of the Japanese people for about two thousand years. This tour you can see how sake is produced and try to taste it.

Soba-making(Buckwheat noodles): Let's try to make soba, a traditional Japanese cuisine, from flour.

EX-2: Kasama Sightseeing (Box Lunch Included)

Date: June 20(Sun) Time: 12:30-18:00 Fare: JPY7,000

Kasama Inari Jinja: Kasama Inari is the god of five grains, of productivity, and of flourishing business.

Craft Hills KASAMA: The Ceramic Arts Museum displays the work of many famous potters. The shape, texture and color of each piece reflect each artist's esthetic sensibility.

Shunpu Banri So: This structure was dismantled and relocated in order to allow visitors to experience the ambience of an Edo-period artist's studio.

EX-3: Tokyo Sightseeing - ASAKUSA - (Box Lunch Included)

Date: June 20(Sun) Time: 12:30-18:30 Fare: JPY9,500

Edo Tokyo Museum: Edo-Tokyo Museum houses various displays which enable visitors to learn the history, life styles and culture of Tokyo, including those in the Edo period.

Asakusa: Asakusa is a typical downtown amusement area where the atmosphere of Edo(Old Tokyo) is still retained. Asakusa-Kannon Temple(Sensoji Temple) is named after the Kannon or Goddess of Mercy.

TOUR CONDITION
